Hussey Compromise:
Exposed Handle even at aisle locations as shown creates a possible trip hazard.

Safety Locking Cover helps assure only authorized personnel will operate the recoverable seating.



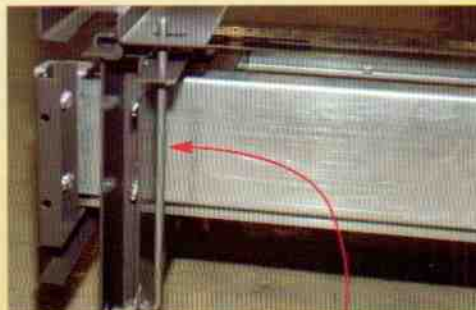
Hussey Compromise:

Inadequate Lead Connector to locking pin results in a maintenance nightmare when it breaks.



Interkal Quality:
Continuous Vertical Engagement Rods provide positive engagement at both front and rear of the continuous locking angle.
